The shipment has been stored for 41 days upon the extended storage permission, must be finally forwarded to the Customs Office (physically to the Customs warehouse) OR upon the approval and under the supervision of the Customs Office, we have to destroy the shipment in question against additional charges (see sub-paragraph B/8.2).**

**The shipments NOT subject to Customs declaration, are stored maximum 41 days, after that the shipments will be destroyed against additional charges (see sub-paragraph B/8.2).**

- Banknotes, coins, other legal tender(s), traveler's cheque, other cheques stand for value or financial claim, share(s), debenture bond, credit card(s), postal stamp(s), bill(s) of exchange, ware receipt(s), air ticket(s);
- Diamond(s), semi and fully precious stone(s), natural or bred pearl(s), or jewelry(ies) made of these;
- Sparkler(s) and/or watch(es) made of gold, platinum, or silver
- All kind of shipment having declared value is or more that 1000 USD/kg, 450 GBP/kg, or equivalent amount of this currencies;
- High-tech goods or their components (e.g.: IT, telecom, office goods);
- Additionally to the goods above all such cargo that:
  - declared by the customer rare and/or unique masterpiece,
  - or the customer requests us to take the cargo so and the tariff was calculated accordingly,
  - or however the customer hasn't requested so, but the tariff was calculated as valuable..
- All goods transported by the airlines as valuable shipment
